I. General Information

- A. This manual contains information regarding installation, operation, and maintenance of the PS Safety Access' SafeMezz® Horizontal Gate.
- B. PS Safety Access recommends that the owner implement a regular maintenance program to inspect the SafeMezz Horizontal Gate as necessary.

II. Operation Guidelines

- A. The SafeMezz Horizontal Gate is designed to meet OSHA Railing Standard 1910.28 and 1910.29.
- B. Operation in a manner other than intended could result in damage or less than acceptable performance at time of need, for which the manufacturer will not be held responsible.

III. Safety Precautions

- A. Ensure opening is clear of all obstructions through the entire proposed travel of the SafeMezz Horizontal Gate during operation.
- B. Comply with all OSHA and ANSI Safety Regulations and/or company safety policies when installing.
- ▲ **DANGER** Ensure area below installation is blocked off from personnel during installation, and mounting surface is capable of supporting all loading. Structural analysis of mounting surface is the responsibility of the owner.

IV. Storage Prior to Installation of Product

A. Store materials in a dry, ventilated location. If outdoor storage is required, block materials and tarp in a tent-like arrangement, elevated above the product with open sides to allow airflow.

V. Installation Site Preparation

NOTICE Before starting site preparation and installation of the SafeMezz Horizontal Gate, read the entire Operation and Maintenance Manual and review all installation instructions thoroughly.

- A. Clear work area of any debris.
- B. Ensure you have the necessary tools available.
- C. Obtained all required permits.
- D. Personnel: Determine the appropriate number of personnel required to perform installation and have them readily available at the project site. (2-3 people recommended)



VI. Installation

A. Please select the attributes you wish to use, this will help for future reference.

Slide Direction: Slide Right to Open (+) Slide Left to Open (-)


STEP 1. Determine your Slide Direction.

a. Look up at the Mezzanine from the ground level to determine what slide direction will be needed.

CRITICAL Your gate should open in the direction that allows the most room for operation.






IMPORTANT! If you have chosen *RIGHT*, you will install your gate using the holes marked with a (+) sign.

IMPORTANT! If you have chosen *LEFT*, you will install your gate using the holes marked with a (-) sign.


NOTICE Installation Step 2 is for Deck Mount Locations ONLY.

(For Face mount Installation refer to Page 14 before continuing to Step 3).


IMPORTANT! Installation steps are shown in **SLIDE DIRECTION**: *RIGHT*.

- **STEP 2.** Installation of Track Assembly.
 - a. Line up leading edge of Track Assembly with leading edge of opening.
 - b. Field fasten Track Assembly to your existing structure using factory located holes.

NOTICE Fasteners provided by others, *NOT* PS Safety Access.




STEP 3. Using supplied hardware from Track Shroud kit begin assembling the Shroud. a. Install the Stop Bracket to the <u>NON-SLIDE DIRECTION</u> of the Shroud.



STEP 4. Install the cover plates found in the Electric Operator Kit.


a. Install Cover Plates over Manual Latch locations (refer to Detail C).




STEP 5. Installation of the Gate Assembly.


a. Install front wheel in the leading end of gate with supplied pin and cotter pin.


CRITICAL Front wheel MUST be in the lower hole location of leading end of Gate Assembly.





STEP 6. Attach UHMW Gate Guide Block to top of Gate Assembly with supplied bolts, washers, and nylock nuts. a. The notch in Guide Block <u>MUST</u> be towards existing structure (refer to Illustration B for correct placement).






NOTICE Existing structure only shown for reference of notch direction.


STEP 7. Install the Belt Plate Assemblies found in the Electric Operator Kit.

a. Attach each Belt Plate Assembly to the Gate with supplied bolts and nuts.



STEP 8. Install Shroud Assembly on Track Assembly.


a. Using supplied $^3\!/^{\!\!\!/}_{\!8}$ washers and nylock nuts attach shroud to top of track assembly.



STEP 9. Installation of the Electric Operator.


- a. Remove cover from Operator and set aside.
- b. Using flat-tipped screwdriver, knock-out holes on shroud side closest to the opening.
- c. Attach Operator to the Shroud Assembly with supplied $\frac{5}{16}$ hex bolts.

CRITICAL Operator MUST be mounted closest to the opening.





STEP 10. Slide Gate assembly into Track and Shroud.

a. Slide gate to fully open position.







STEP 11. Install Shroud Block with supplied screws, and nuts.

a. Shroud Block <u>MUST</u> be installed on open edge of Shroud Assembly with the widest side away from the vertical track support.






STEP 12. Install Stop Jamb onto Existing Structure.

- a. Slide gate to fully open position.
- b. Field fasten Stop Jamb vertically, refer to Details for correct dimensions.






FRONT VIEW








CRITICAL Do NOT cut belt until SafeMezz Horizontal Gate is assembled and operating smoothly.

STEP 13. Install the Belt found in the Electric Operator Kit.

a. With cogs in belt facing downward, run belt as shown in illustrations.








VII. Installation of optional Face Mount Track (Sold separately)

A. Once steps have been completed, continue with Shroud Assembly on Page 5.

STEP 1. Installation of Face Mount Track.

- a. Field fasten track $\frac{1}{4}$ " below top of the mezzanine deck.
- b. Face Mount Track must be 4" beyond the end of the opening in the direction of slide (refer to Detail P for proper dimensioning).



STEP 2. Installation of Track Assembly.

- a. Place Gate Housing Track on top of the Face Mount Track and line it up with the supplied holes.
- b. Attach Gate Housing Track to Face Mount Track with supplied carriage bolts and nylock nuts.
- c. Field fasten Gate Housing Track to your existing structure using factory located holes.



Inspection and Maintenance

X. Inspection and Maintenance (Minimum Annually)

IMPORTANT! Consult parts list before replacing fasteners, as all have specific design load requirements. Only use like items for replacement.

A. Gate/Frame:

- 1. Inspect components for damage and misalignment. Adjust, repair, or replace as needed, to meet original design tolerance.
- 2. Check gate for proper alignment with track assembly. Adjust as necessary to achieve proper alignment.

B. Fasteners and mechanical connections

- 1. All fasteners must be in place and adjusted to their original design standard. Replace any damaged components.
- 2. Check all mounting connections, making sure they meet original design standards (refer to instructions).

C. Finishes

- 1. Inspect and clean finishes periodically.
- 2. Touch up repair finishes, or refinish as necessary to protect the structural integrity of the SafeMezz Horizontal Gate.
- 3. The SafeMezz Horizontal Gate comes with a polyester powder coat finish. Use finish materials compatible with powder coat. Follow paint manufacturers' instructions for prep and touch-up.

D. Housekeeping

- 1. To ensure your product continues to operate and last, upon completion of proper installation, complete the following:
 - a. Clean all surfaces.
 - b. If project is ongoing, protect installed products until final completion of project.
 - c. Touch-up, repair, or replace damaged components.
- 2. Ensure the track assembly is clear of debris and interferences.

E. Labels and Placards:

- 1. Inspect all labels and placards.
- 2. Replace any labels and placards which are unreadable/missing.
